**RULES AND REGULATIONS
EMPIRE STATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF CARPENTERS
SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

1. The Scholarship Fund shall award a total of eight (8) scholarships with an annual stipend of \$2,000 per scholarship for a period of four (4) years each. Two (2) scholarships shall be awarded within each Region of the Empire State Regional Council of Carpenters.
2. To qualify, the applicant must be the natural or legally adopted son/daughter of a member in good standing of the Empire State Regional Council of Carpenters, a full-time employee of the Council, an employee on whose behalf contributions are made to a constituent fringe benefit fund affiliated with the Empire State Regional Council of Carpenters, or an individual in pension pay status from an affiliated pension fund of the Empire State Regional Council of Carpenters.
3. Applicants will be considered eligible without regard to age, provided:
 - a. they are unmarried;
 - b. entering college as a freshman without prior college credit;
 - c. entering college with prior college credit earned while completing the senior year of high school in either an early admissions or advanced placement program;
 - d. a mid-year graduate who entered college prior to the academic year beginning in September, when a scholarship would first be payable.
4. The awards will be sent directly to the college only and credited to the student's account for payment of authorized covered expenses (tuition in college, accommodations, room and board and documented matriculation and other usual and similar fees).
5. In order to maintain scholarship status, an individual must be a full-time student, within the definition of the criteria established by their respective school, and he/she must maintain a C or higher grade point average.
6. For children of eligible employees, who will be February or June high school graduates, applications must be obtained from your Local Union office.
No application will be acted upon by the Council Office without the complete high school records certified by that school.

TO THE APPLICANT:

If you are to graduate from high school in January/June 2010, and you meet the requirements on the attached list of rules and regulations, you can be considered for a scholarship award.

We require the following information:

- a. Complete the attached application.
- b. Attach a letter to the application giving your reason for applying and what you are looking for in higher education. Upon submission all letters shall become the sole property of the Empire State RC of Carpenters Scholarship Fund. The Empire State RC of Carpenters Scholarship Fund retains the right to provide such letters to the Empire State RC of Carpenters for publication in its newsletters, pamphlets, webpage or other publications.
- c. Secure an official transcript of your high school scholastic record and rank in class and attach it to the application.
- d. Complete the affidavit and have your parent sign it. This must be notarized.
- e. Request three teachers of your high school faculty to write a letter of recommendation and send it to this office.
- f. Return all items to the Empire State Regional Council of Carpenters Scholarship Fund, 270 Motor Parkway, Dept. A., Hauppauge, NY 11788 postmarked no later than April 09, 2010. All items must be received by this office by April 23, 2010 to be considered. All information received subsequent to this date will not be considered and your application will not be considered without all the required information.
